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Contract awarded for state recreation area improvements in Jefferson County

SPRINGFIELD – A contract totaling more than \$87,000 has been awarded to replace the roofing systems at Wayne Fitzgerald State Recreation Area in Jefferson County by the Capital Development Board (CDB), which administers all state-funded, non-road construction projects.

The contract was awarded January 13 following a state-mandated competitive bidding process. The work involves replacing approximately 11,000 square feet of roofing system on four buildings. The project is part of Governor Pat Quinn's *Illinois Jobs Now!* capital construction program.

The successful bidder was Joiner Sheet Metal & Roofing Inc. of Greenville, Illinois, the lowest of seven bidders at \$87,800. The project is expected to be complete by summer.

Overlooking the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers' 19,000-acre Rend Lake Reservoir, Wayne Fitzgerald State Recreation Area is a gateway to Southern Illinois' biggest
