Contract awarded for state construction project at DeWitt County rest area

SPRINGFIELD – A contract totaling more than \$88,000 has been awarded to replace the roofing systems at the Farmland rest area along Interstate 74 near Farmer City in DeWitt County by the Capital Development Board (CDB), which administers all state-funded, non-road construction projects.

“This project, one of many in Governor Quinn’s *Illinois Jobs Now!* capital construction program, will put people to work and help maintain this state-owned property,” said CDB Executive Director Jim Riemer.

The contract was awarded November 15 following a state-mandated competitive bidding process. The work involves replacing the roofing systems on the east and westbound Farmland Rest Areas. The successful bidder was Geissler Roofing Co, Inc. of Belleville, Illinois on their bid of \$88,725. They were among five firms submitting bids. The work should be complete by late Spring 2011.
